Modern Minimal allows the focus to be on something more than space. Everything should be functional and add value to the room; for example, in a dining room, we need a table and chairs - these items have to 'speak' to one another and have to be capable of relating in terms of form, colour, lines, shape. They must work together in their raw shape to create an intense space. The design architecture includes the use of reductive design elements, without ornamentation or decoration, condensing the content and form of the design to its bare essentials. It reveals to be the core essence of the Modern Minimal interiors.

When creating a Modern Minimal ambience, it is all about base colour: unobtrusive hues are the key here - from eggshell, light greys, beiges and every other earth inspired tone in between - for these colours have a fresh, clean look that inspires a sense of calm. A space with natural light is most likely to look warmer, so keep an open floor plan, using also a cooler shade of white to balance the room. When adding pops of colour, be sure to use solid pigments which are pleasant to the eyes and fuse well with the neutrals that you already have.

When incorporating the Modern Minimal design to common areas such as the kitchen, we should not only make sure to incorporate the necessary appliances and seating required, but also ensure that each extent is imbued with its own sense of style. Combining a soft and neutral colour, such as white, with wood is at the core of this style, and so is giving a slice of colour such as black. White and black kitchens are a common sight in the Modern Minimal style. In this simple design, bits of colour in the way of natural wood, yellow, and red manages to shine through.

A monochromatic colour palette can make a space look cold, so using a combination of different shades, tints and textures will help to create a dynamic atmosphere. Keep your living room as clean, open and uncluttered as possible to create a modern contemporary feel. Sleek leather sofas and chairs paired with glass and chrome coffee tables and side tables can help upgrade the space to a more formal setting. Add in some

Modern Contemporary furniture should make a bold statement, so make sure you choose items that have smooth, clean geometric shapes with neutral tones, using the natural fibres found in wool, cotton, linen, and silk; pillows can add a pop of colour and texture. For having a light-toned background, your favourite colour can stand out in your furniture.

Sofas, chairs and ottomans have exposed legs, there are no fringes or ruffles, every item is bold and structural. When considering lighting, consider installing indirect light, and using products that have colour and metallic elements on the light fixtures. Use direct lighting when you want to draw focus to something: a painting, a poster, a sculpture, framed art. Generous use of metal and clear glass helps to soften and warm-up space.



When decorating a Modern Contemporary bedroom, make sure the bed is the focal point, keep your bedding tucked in and sleek with minimum throw pillows to accentuate its lines. Stick to cabinets, bedside tables and other furniture with clean lines, sharp angles and rich, dark colour to fade into the background of the design. 
MODERN CLASSIC
